#### **Overview**



### What happens at your event?

The day will begin with a short briefing given by your facilitator on how everything will run. They will then split the room up into separate teams, assigning a section of the large painting to each to paint.

With only a few members from each team are allowed to see the full painting, it's up to them to communicate clearly and effectively to explain what they see so that their teammates can paint their section as accurately as they can. Painters will also need to bear in mind and discuss how each section is going to fit together.

At the end of the activity, all the sections from each team will be brought together in an attempt to re-create the full painting in its entirety.
