After testing and (eventually) passing your vehicle's MOT, it'll be time to take to the tracks to battle it out in a series of races against the other teams!

With points awarded to the winners of each race, those with the highest points scored by the end of the activity will be crowned the winners of the day in a medals ceremony for first and second place.
